CRUNCH AND READ!

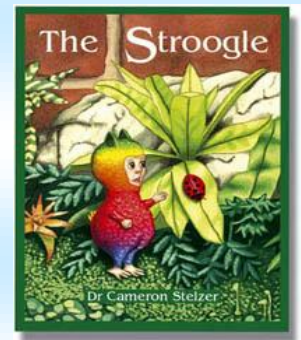
